- Internal process has been initiated awaiting finalization with advise from legal
- 2. Bontebok applications for import into the USA
- USFW visit to South Africa
- Applications are currently being processed. Clients who previously submitted may need to submit new applications
- 3. Lion applications to the USA
- Wild lions being processed

- 2. Date of first breeding and first production of F2 specimens.
- 3. Description and photographs of the breeding method and facilities of the breeder
- 4. Current (breeding) stock (number and age of adult males, adult females, and (unsexed) juveniles)
- 5. Number of offspring per year over the past 5 years
- 6. Mortality rates
- 7. Number of animals from the wild added per year
- 8. Reports of inspections by MA and/or SA of South Africa

Hunting stats 2022

- Period of stats reflected: 1 January 2022 to 31
 December 2022
- Pricelist are requested from outfitters and an average of the amounts is used to determine the prices for each species.
- To ensure that the statistics remains reliable, the average species prices and daily rate is determined from pricelists of the same outfitters every year.
